For 2010-2011, Academy of Westland has made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in English language arts and mathematics. While we are pleased to have reached this important goal, we are continuously working to improve. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff and our community in this effort.

The School Improvement Plan for the 2011/2012 school year has been submitted to the state for approval.

The Academy of Westland has aligned its curriculum in all (K-8) subject areas to the Michigan Core Curriculum Framework (MCF), Benchmarks and incorporates the Grade Level Content Expectations (GLCE) as a key assessment reference. All teachers will receive a copy of the curriculum with the objectives for every subject. Teachers will develop lessons that will specifically target those objectives that are to be met.

To ensure that the curriculum is being fully implemented in the classroom, the following steps are taken;

1. Lesson plans will be evaluated by the administration to verify that objectives are being addressed.
2. Administrators will make classroom visits to ensure lessons are appropriately delivered to students.
3. Weekly grade level meetings will be held to plan lessons, develop rubrics that are aligned to classroom assessment, develop scope and sequence for content subject areas, share instructional strategies, etc.
4. Pre and post-test are given to students to measure growth in the content areas.
5. Student's knowledge of entrepreneurship is assessed by starting and operating a classroom business.
